Directions: **From Camelford:** Take the B3266 road towards Bodmin for ~8miles – the Colquite Farm Estate is on the left hand side of the road (2<sup>nd</sup> signpost on right hand side of road) – directions will be given from the Estate entrance.

**From Wadebridge:** Take the A389 towards Bodmin – in Washaway turn left onto Old School Lane for 0.4 miles (past the entrance to Pencarrow House), turn left onto the B3266 – after ~1 mile the Colquite Farm Estate is on the right hand side of the road (signpost on left hand side of road) – directions will be given from the Estate entrance.

**From Bodmin:** Take the A389 towards Wadebridge - turn right onto the B3266 Camelford road – after ~1.5 miles the Colquite Farm Estate is on the right hand side of the road (signpost on left hand side of road) – directions will be given from the Estate entrance.
