Team – Recurve (2 mixed shooting Hereford)  
Compound (2 mixed shooting Hereford).

Notes: Archery GB rules on dress code & shooting will apply.  
Juniors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Photographs: Use of all cameras MUST be registered with the Tournament Organiser.

Directions: **From Camelford:** Take the B3266 road towards Bodmin for ~8miles – the Colquite Estate is on the left hand side of the road.  
**From Wadebridge:** Take the A389 towards Bodmin – in Washaway turn left onto Old School Lane for 0.4 miles (past the entrance to Pencarrow House), turn left onto the B3266 – after ~1 mile the Colquite Estate is on the right hand side of the road.  
**From Bodmin:** Take the A389 towards Wadebridge - turn right onto the B3266 Camelford road – after ~1.5 miles the Colquite Estate is on the right hand side of the road.

Disabled parking by arrangement with the Tournament Organiser. Please advise of any special requirements on reverse of entry.
